## Holy Trinity Headington Quarry Working at Height\* Policy

No untrained individuals will work at height and where possible all working at height should be avoided.

If working at height is required, then only professional contractors should be employed and the work planned in advance. The contractor should ensure scaffolding is used where needed and if a ladder has to be used, the ladder should be checked for safety before and after use by the contractor.

At HTHQ, the only areas where working at height would be deemed necessary would be electrical work e.g. changing light bulbs, which would be done by an approved electrical contractor or building work which would be done by contracted approved builders.

HTHQ already does have a ladder locked to the North church wall but it is not recommended to use this as contractors should have their own equipment.
